Go For It Gorilla

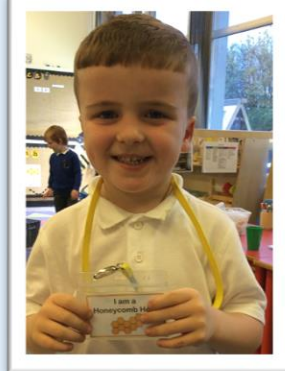
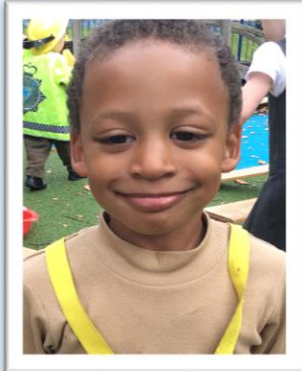
